








# Tomahawk




Draw decorations for the tomahawk.




Draw yourself as a colonial Soldier.




# WWI “Doughboy”

and a Mark IV Tank




12 pounder "Napoleon"





HMMWVs are painted to match the terrain around them. Draw the landscape behind the vehicle, and then give the HMMWV camouflage to match.


