The Army Heritage Trail is open from dawn to dusk. Trail buildings are open during normal business hours.







# Ridgway Hall



Ridgway Hall is the home to the U.S. Army Military History Institute (USAMHI). Founded in 1967 and located on Carlisle Barracks, USAMHI spent years collecting materials with historical significance to the U.S. Army. After more than three decades of acquiring documents, manuscripts, and artifacts, USAMHI became part of a larger organization as the U.S. Army Heritage and Education Center (USAHEC) formed in 2001. With an evolving mission and a need for more space, the USAHEC built Ridgway Hall and moved to its present location in 2004.
