**DUTIES:** Develops, executes, assesses seminar-based educational program for senior US and international military officers and government civilians culminating in award of Master of Strategic Studies degree. Mentors students in development of critical professional competencies including national-level policy and strategy analysis and development. Supervises student Strategy Research Projects. Develops, coordinates, and teaches educational programs on international political economy, globalization, national security economics, to include electives; advises USAWC leadership, department chairman, and faculty in the role and use of economics in the curriculum; represents USAWC at professional conferences; conducts research for publication. As required, provides strategic and operational expertise to national-level, Combatant Command, and other strategic and operational headquarters.

**QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

1. Must have an established record of superlative teaching at the graduate or Senior Service College levels.
2. Substantial preference will be given to candidates with an earned doctorate in economics or a related field.
3. Demonstrated expertise and experience in national security issues.
4. Ability to prepare, coordinate, supervise, teach and lecture on subjects relating to economics, international political economy, globalization, national security economics, and national security.
5. A record of active participation in professional outreach programs, and a record of publication in professional refereed journals are highly desirable.
6. Ability to construct, organize, coordinate, manage, and supervise graduate-level educational, research and outreach programs to increase the professional
