

Job Title: Chair, Department of Military Strategy, Planning, and Operations

DUTIES: Supervise, manage, and lead the Department of Military Strategy, Planning, and Operations. Develop and supervise execution of graduate-level core curricula focusing on the development, implementation, and assessment of Theater Strategies and Campaign Plans. Support the design and execution of the Advanced Strategic Art Program. Oversee and direct a relevant, highly valued electives program. Lead a faculty of 17 senior military officers from all services, eight Title 10 Army civilian professors, and an administrative staff of four. Promote department interests in support of US Army War College objectives and goals. Preserve future through recruitment, retention, and professional development of faculty and staff. Develop and manage an annual budget. Actively participate in college-wide administrative, academic and governance requirements as determined by US Army War College leadership.

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

- Must be a U.S. Army Officer in the rank of Colonel capable of full time active service
- Must have or be able to obtain and maintain a Top Secret clearance
- Must have completed Military Education Level 1 (MEL 1)
- Must have at least a master's degree in a field related to the Department's curriculum
- Must be able to serve at least two years in the position
- Must be able and willing to travel worldwide
- Should be available for assignment to the U.S. Army War College no later than June 2016

SELECTIVE PLACEMENT FACTORS/KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES (KSAs):

Applicants will be rated on the criteria listed below by a panel of subject matter experts appointed with the purpose of identifying the best-qualified candidates.

1. Established record of superlative teaching at the graduate or Senior Service College levels.
2. Experience working in the planning and/or operations sections of the Joint Staff, Geographic or Functional Combatant Commands, Component Commands of Geographic or Functional Combatant Commands or Joint Task Force(s).
3. Demonstrated expertise and experience in U.S. military strategic and theater-strategic planning, to include experience developing theater campaign and contingency plans as well as crisis response plans and operations.
4. Ability to supervise the development and delivery of the department's course material within the core and elective curricula. When required, teach courses and give presentations on subjects relating to the development, execution, and assessment of theater strategies and plans.
5. Ability to supervise graduate-level educational, research, and outreach programs to increase the professional knowledge and competence of other faculty and students.

6. Demonstrated competence in joint military operations and doctrine. Preference will be given to individuals with Joint Professional Military Education level II (JPME II) qualification.

7. Demonstrated communication skills, such as authorship of national or theater-level strategies and plans, publication in professional journals, submission of papers for examination, and/or lectures presented.

8. Exemplary record of leadership.
