POLITICAL HANDBOOK OF THE WORLD (JF37 .P6)

Examines political developments and provides economic facts about nations, dependent territories and major intergovernmental organizations such as NATO, OPEC, and UN affiliates.

Provides annual 18-month and five-year political and economic forecasts for 100 individual countries. These country reports examine specific regime scenarios, and are highly valued for future planning; calculating risk ratings for turmoil, as well as financial transfers, export markets, and direct investments.
