##### ASIA YEARBOOK (HC412 F3)

Provides a comprehensive survey of significant political and economic events for more than thirty Asian countries or territories within the region. It also covers areas of regional and national significance such as military power, trade, energy and commodities.

Compiled from U.S. Department of State's regional bureau reports to provide detailed information about a country's people, history, government, political conditions, economy, U.S. and foreign relations, travel, and business. ### **MILITARY**

#### DEFENSE & FOREIGN AFFAIRS HANDBOOK (UA10 D3)

Covers 245 countries and territories for political and constitutional data; defense structure, budgets, manpower, and battle orders for all military services; treaties; key embassies; major intelligence services; and insurgency groups.

#### MILITARY BALANCE (UA15 I5)

Published annually by the International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS) to provide quantitative assessment of the military power and defense expenditures of individual countries. This handbook is generally considered to be the best of its kind.

#### STRATEGIC SURVEY: AN EVALUATION AND FORECAST OF WORLD AFFAIRS (UA15 I51)

Produced by the International Institute for Strategic Studies (IISS), this reference work offers current strategic, political, and defense assessments of world regions.

## **POLITICS**

### **POLITICAL HANDBOOK OF THE WORLD (JF37 P6)**

Published annually to update political developments and economic facts about nations, dependent territories and major intergovernmental organizations such as NATO, OPEC, and UN affiliates.

### **POLITICAL RISK YEARBOOK (HD2755.5 P66)**

Provides 18-month and five-year political and economic forecasts for individual countries contained within each regional volume. Regions included are:

### **SIPRI YEARBOOK (JX1974 S775)**

Reviews recent regional and worldwide developments in weapons, military spending, international arms trade and other issues related to armaments, disarmament and international security.

### **STATESMAN'S YEARBOOK (JA51 S75)**

Offers descriptive and statistical information on the world's politics, cultures, and economies. It also includes social institutions, environmental data, and key historical events.

### **TREATIES AND ALLIANCES OF THE WORLD (KZ1301 T74)**

Identifies, in a one-volume guide, major treaties and alliances currently in force.

### **WORLD MILITARY AND SOCIAL EXPENDITURES (UA17 S59)**

Provides an annual account of the use of world resources for social and military purposes.

## **ECONOMICS**

### **COUNTRY BY COUNTRY (HB3730 E251)**

Continues *World Outlook* for annual forecasts of the political and economic prospects of more than 180 countries.

### **U.S. CENSUS BUREAU INTERNATIONAL DATA BASE**

**WORLD ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL SURVEY: TRENDS AND POLICIES IN THE WORLD ECONOMY (HC59 U6)**

Published annually by the United Nations for analysis of the state of the world economy and emerging policy issues.

**RESEARCH DATABASES**

Below are selected online commercial databases available in the U.S. Army War College Library and through the Carlisle Barracks local area network. They offer access to electronic journal articles, reports, working papers, books, and related resources.

**COLUMBIA INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS ONLINE (CIAO)**

Is a comprehensive source for theory and research in international affairs. Includes working papers from university research institutes, conference proceedings, occasional papers series from NGOs, books, journals, and policy briefs.

**COUNTRYWATCH.COM**

Offers political, economic, historical, cultural, environmental, and business information of the countries of the world.

**FACTS.COM**

Offers current facts, statistics, country profiles, maps, editorial opinion, news art, photos, and historic documents connected to the story.

**JANE’S SENTINEL**

Consists of *Jane’s Sentinel Security Assessments* for nations’ political, security, and military affairs. Each region is organized by country profiles, and includes analysis of the latest trends and events; detailed analyses of internal and external threats; and overviews of armed forces, security and foreign forces.

Consists of three databases: Status of Multilateral Treaties Deposited with the Secretary-General for 500 major multilateral instruments; United Nations Treaty Series (UNTS) for registered treaties since 1946; and Texts of Recently Deposited Multilateral Treaties, recorded but not yet published.
