- Advance notice from current students staying at Carlisle Barracks, is appreciated. This will allow BBC to determine permanent party home assignments and unaccompanied request to remain in current home, allowing BBC time to prepare for incoming student assignments.
- Preterm inspections will be the week of April 6-10, 2015, more information to follow from the BBC office. Please keep an eye out for your neighborhood times via email.
- USAWC NSS memo approval required for move outs during the week of June 1-5, 2015.
- 30 Day Notice to Vacate Form turned into BBC office with transportation confirmation to schedule final move out date. Notice can be provided in advance which allow students to secure move out date of preference.
- Schedule Move out Inspection in the office when transportation is confirmed. Last day for current students to remain in homes is Friday June 26, 2015 unless exception filed and approved.
- Move out Inspections start at 07:45 a.m.-4:00 p.m. Monday-Friday. 30 minute blocked segments-2 specialists out at time, No Saturday/Sunday/Holiday Inspections.
- Cleaning- 2 options
  - Clean it yourself- Please refer to Resident Guide online or Handout for additional guidelines and specifications for cleaning your home.
  - Pay n Go- Minimum cleaning standards are required to clear your home Follow Minimum Cleaning Standard Sheet \*\*\*Additional charges may apply.
- Allotment Choices- (Remember, rent is paid in arrears End of May allotment is for May rent)
  - Prepay to stop allotment, Deadline to stop allotment May 25, 2015 by NOON for the month of June 2015.
  - Or we collect allotment at end of month and refund your prorata to you by check or automatic credit to the account of your choice -please provide voided check if auto credit desired. Please leave forwarding address for check...
- Your final utility bill estimate can be paid in advance of your final inspection date. These will be ready in the files one week prior. If you are due a YES refund, then this can be mailed to you or deducted from any damages you may owe to BBC.
