

Shuttle starts at 0600, 11 Mar








Parking Areas: CL-V1, Fire House, Ann Ely, Wright Ave, Ligget Road

USAG Support to NSSR(NYC)

- ***Enhanced Child & Youth Program support***
 - Hourly Care (10 slots); registration opens 30 days out
 - Extended Youth Center hours & programming
- ***Heightened Security***
 - Increased patrols in housing areas
 - Individual Quarters check upon request; NLT 5 Mar 15
- ***Facilitated Installation Access for Care Givers***
 - Temporary Access Passes issued by Dir, Emergency Svcs
 - To apply, visit Police Desk daily
 - Ensure Family members still have updated registration & insurance cards for random inspections



USAG Support to NSSR (NYC)

- ***Accessible Legal Assistance***
 - POAs required for medical/dental care of dependents staying with other than parent or legal guardian
 - Power of Attorney (POA) & Notary Services available NOW (walk-in) from 0800-1500 daily in Upton Hall
- ***Medical/Dental Care***
 - Reminder that the children's ID card is required (if applicable); leave with care givers



Impact of BAH Reduction on Carlisle Barracks

- Balfour Beatty Communities will continue to only charge Service Members their applicable BAH rate
- Renter's insurance will no longer be provided as a component of BAH
- Current residents already receiving Renter's Insurance will continue to receive Renter's Insurance through BBC until December 31, 2015; after this date, rent at your own risk without insurance
- Incoming Service Members executing a new lease will not receive Renter's Insurance coverage.
 - Incoming Service Members includes inbound PCS as well as those moving from off the Installation onto the Installation
 - Service Members will be encouraged to purchase their own Renter's Insurance
- Garrison CSM will prepare brief on subject for Enlisted Soldiers
