
Snow Removal

Roll-Up from Past Two CLIFs (1)

- **For next year: do not schedule sports physicals day on same day as county fair – (acknowledged and will do)**
- **Comments in regards to information put out by the SLO – (Commandant met with SLO; noted; need SLO to attend CLIFs as well)**
- **Select sidewalks in disrepair; safety issue – (Garrison inspected; is repairing sidewalk crossings post-wide)**
- **Hours “not as advertised” at Dunham for flu shots – (noted; passed on to Clinic Commander; will ensure not an issue)**
- **Not enough available appointments at clinic – (discussed last CLIF; re-visit)**
- **Off-post personnel use of meeting room and attending classes at Balfour Beatty Facility (Delaney Clubhouse) – (discussed last CLIF; re-visit)**

Roll-Up from Past Two CLIFs (2)

- PX comments: desire larger clothing sales department, expanded product line for cold meds; and expanded hours for the CL VI -- (revisit?; Commandant will meet with PX Management)
- Young Hall "shifting windows" issue -- (passed to BBC; might need revisit)
- Disrespect at ID card Section -- (passed to Garrison Commander; reminded of importance of customer service)

- "Stickerless" cars issue -- (double-checked Carlisle Barracks procedures; all good; need to know specific installation and will work for you)

Roll-Up from Past Two CLIFs (3)

- With high number of off-post personnel, 0900 hours start times for events are problematic; recommend start times for major events NET 1000 hours -- (Commandant says "WILCO")
- Numerous comments about service at LVCC during Air Shipwreck Ball and Dance Classes -- (command group hot washed Air Shipwreck Ball configuration; we've outgrown current execution plan; will modify; revisit Dance Classes bar service?)
