3x5 Card Roll up from Oct CLIF (1)

- ***Question/Comment #1: “What is the update on staffing at the Dunham Army Health Clinic? I have received numerous complaints from members of my seminar about services received at the pediatric clinic (poor bedside manner, unable to make timely appointments, rushed appointments).”***
- ***DAHIC COMMANDER RESPONSE:***
 - Over the past 30 days, Dunham has added four additional providers to the clinic staff. A fifth provider will return in November to rejoin our staff after completing a yearlong deployment. All of these providers see both children and adults. Appointment times have also been lengthened in the clinic providing the nurse/provider teams additional time to assist with the individual patient's needs.

- **Question/Comment #2:** *“When speakers are at the USAWC from regions that will involve student’s follow-on assignment, is it possible for the student to meet them?”*
- **G3 RESPONSE:**
 - Based on students' receipt of follow-on assignment orders, we will attempt to link up students with senior leaders, subject to availability and time here at the USAWC.



3x5 Card Roll up from Oct CLIF (3)

- ***Question/Comment #3: “Why are Active Duty faculty spouses prevented from taking full part in opportunities in which student spouses are highly encouraged to engage?”***
- ***MILITARY FAMILY PROGRAM RESPONSE:***
 - All Active Duty faculty spouses are encouraged to take part in all events on Carlisle Barracks. The only program that gives priority to Student Spouses is FLAGS Facilitator training. We do that for three reasons: First, the USAWC contracts for the four weeks of FLAGS Facilitator training and with one instructor, we have to limit the number trained. Second, we give priority to Student Spouses due to the short time that they are assigned to Carlisle Barracks. Third, our FLAGS Facilitator training is focused on preparing graduates for “Peer-to-Peer” instruction of other Student Spouses. We are developing a Senior Spouse Leadership Certificate Program that we believe will offer a more comprehensive offering for all Spouses (Students, Staff and Faculty).



3x5 Card Roll up from Oct CLIF (4)

- **Question/Comment #4:** *“What is the policy that allows off post organizations (such as local high schools) to use on-post facilities- such as the Thorpe Gym? At certain times of the day equipment is not available for ID card holders because it is being used for training by local HS teams.”*
- **USAG CDR RESPONSE:**
 - The Garrison Commander approves off-post organizations' use of fitness centers on a case-by-case basis.
 - We do have a USAWC Faculty Instructor who has been providing exercise training in our fitness centers to six local high school athletes, all of whom are at least 16 years of age, DOD ID card holders and family members eligible to use the fitness facilities.

- ***Question/Comment #5: “Is it possible to have the port-a-potty relocated that is currently in front of Young Hall? The necessity is understandable, but its current location is unsightly for residents.”***
- ***USAG CDR RESPONSE:***
 - The port-a-potties have been moved to the side of the Indian Field stands.



3x5 Card Roll up from Oct CLIF (6)

- **Question/Comment #6: “Is it possible to get screen doors installed on the houses in Heritage Heights/Meadows? Some houses have no windows on or around the front door and it would be nice to be able to see kids playing outside alone with being able to create a nice breeze having both doors with screens. Might create energy savings.**
 - **Allow residents to purchase screen doors and have BBC install them.**
 - **Have BBC buy and install storm doors.”**

- **USAG CDR RESPONSE:**
 - The new construction homes were not designed to support the structure of a screen door. Screen doors are not planned for in the current installation budget; however USAG CBKS will consider this request when developing future housing requirements.

- **USAG CDR RESPONSE:**
 - The Garrison Commander would like to discuss this suggestion in greater detail with the requester following the CLIF if he/she is in attendance.

- ***Question/Comment #8: “Are the houses (new and old) on Carlisle Barracks fitted with carbon monoxide detectors?”***
- ***USAG CDR RESPONSE:***
 - All homes have smoke detectors, CO2 detectors and fire stops installed. They are hard wired into the homes.

- ***Question/Comment #9: “Thank you for the infant swings at the park! Have you considered installing play equipment for smaller children? Many have toddlers and the playground equipment is a little high for the little ones.”***
- ***USAG CDR RESPONSE:***
 - We do not currently have a plan to add additional playground equipment. However, Garrison is surveying the playgrounds to ensure we have a suitable age range of equipment available across the Installation.

- ***Question/Comment #10: “Is it possible to get a mailbox in the Meadows? Currently, the closest outgoing mailbox is in the PX parking lot. Thank you!”***
- ***USAG CDR RESPONSE:***

- ❄ **Established priorities for snow removal are dependent upon volume of snowfall, time and the day of the week, but primarily in the order indicated on the following slide.**
- ❄ **Priority is also given to main thoroughfare sidewalks to allow students to walk to class.**




Housing Resident Responsibilities
